This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of April 29th, with reference to the well of the Western Drilling Company or Hobbs High Well in Section 35, T. 18 S., R. 38 E. I am enclosing a copy of my letter to D. C. Crowell & Co., General Agents of El Paso, Texas in this connection.

I find that we have in our files a copy of the official log of this well. We are keeping the various forms pertaining to this well consisting of "Notice of Intention to Drill New Well", "Notice of Intention to Abandon Well", "Notice of Intention to Shoot Well" and the "Well Record" in our files. We should, of course, have a final report giving the results of the abandonment before the case is closed.

I suggest that you place in your own files a notation of the forms which are contained in the files of this office regarding this well.
