NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Lizzie Rice  
Well No. 1 in SE CORNER Sec. 13, T. 18 S, R. 37E,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs, New Mexico Oil Field Lea County,  
on August 18, 1932 7" 24 lb. casing was XXXXX cemented in Ann & Line  
formation at a depth of 3922 feet on August 14, 1932 19  
250 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

**Cement was pumped down by Halliburton leaving 26' in the casing**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 3922 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
