NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Lizzie Rice  
Well No. 1 in SE Cor. of Sec. 13, T. 18 S, R. 37 E,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,  
on July 31 st 19 32 lb. casing was 1 inch cemented in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 2786 feet feet on July 28 th 19 32  
600 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

**Cement was pumped down by Haliburton using two-plug method leaving 29' of cement in casing.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 2000' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
