NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in **State A 33 Lease** Well No. **5** in **S.E.** of Sec. **33**, T. **18S**, R. **30E**, N. M. P. M., **Hobbs** Oil Field **Lea** County, on **Nov. 15** 19**31** **9-5/8"** **40** lb. casing was ~~drilled~~ cemented in **Anhydrite** formation at a depth of **2755** feet on **Nov. 7** 19**31** **600** sacks of **El Toro** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Halliburton method, plug pumped to 2725'. On Nov. 15 the casing was bailed and tested and found OK as to shut off and consistency of the cement.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
