NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TREAT WELL WITH ACID

Dear Sir: You are hereby notified that it is our intention to treat one of our producing wells with acid, which well is known as State A-33 Well No. 5 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 18 S R 36 E, in the Hobbs field.

The well is 660' North of the South Line
and 1980' West of the East Line of Sec. 33,

T 18 S, R 36 E

The Oil and gas lease is No. 1148

DUPLICATE

The lease is Continental Oil Company, Address, Ponca City, Okla.

The surface elevation is 3624.76

Will lead the hole with sufficient oil to kill the well,
after which 1000 gallons of acid will be pumped through
the tubing and treat formation 3990 to 4184'

WORK TO START: Upon receipt of approval.

DETAILS & PLAN OF WORK: State A-33 Well No. 5 had an average gas-oil ratio during the month of November, 1933 of 5620 cuft of gas to one barrel of oil; an increase of 2926 cuft per barrel oil over that of October. It is our intention to treat the well with 1000 gallons of acid in an effort to reduce the gas-oil ratio and conserve gas. If we are unsuccessful in obtaining a satisfactory ratio after treatment, we will then consider packer installation to obtain the desired results. The well was completed December 13, 1931 at a total depth of 4184', the 7" casing
