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short period of time while drilling through them to the intermediate casing point. To that end it is essential that a completely reliable cement job on the 8 5/8-inch intermediate casing string be obtained. While it is recognized that cement was circulated on the 8 5/8-inch casing, we feel that further assurance of a good cement job may be obtained by running a cement bonding log on the 8 5/8-inch casing upon completion of drilling to total depth.

The Commission's Hobbs office is therefore being asked to request such a log from Texaco Inc. if they have not done so already.
