On January 29, 1964 - 11,416' or 4 1/2" N-80 11.6 new casing was cemented at 11,432' with 600 sacks regular cement plus 200 cu. ft. stratacrete. P.D. @4:15 PM.

After 24 hrs. a pressure of 1000 psi was applied at the surface for 30 min. There was no pressure loss.

The well was gun perforated (11325-11337), (11343-11348), (11350-11356), (11361-11371), 4 shots per ft. on January 31, 1964. Ran 2" tubing to 11390' and acidized Feb. 1, 1964 with 1000 gal of mud acid. The well is being tested and potentialized at this time.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
