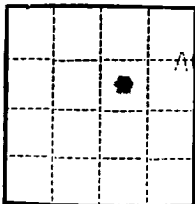

DETAILS OF WORK

Cactus Drilling Company spudded 17-1/4" at 4-00PM on 8-30-63. On 8-31-63, 13-3/8" OD 35.6# Armo 2J casing was run and set at 332' with 120 sz. cement. Cement circulated. After 18 hours tested casing with 600 PSI for 30 minutes. Test OK. Reduced hole to 11" at 336' and resumed drilling operations.

As of 7:00 AM on 9-2-63, well was drilling at a depth of 900'.

As of 7:00 AM on 9-3-63, well was drilling at a depth of 1260'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
