Big West Drilling Co., Midland, Texas, spudded 17-1/2" hole at 3:30 PM on 12-28-63. On 12-31-63, 13-3/8" OD 48# H-40 ST&C casing was set at 826' and cemented with 750 sx cement. Cement circulated. After 300 lb hrs, tested casing with 600 PSI for 30 minutes. Test O.K. Reduced hole to 12-1/2" at 826' and resumed drilling operations.
