Spudded well 12:00 noon, 10-17-64. Drilled 12 1/2" hole to 1611 feet. Cemented 8-5/8", 32 1/2 ft., J-55, SMC, new casing at 1600 feet with 1070 sz. cement. Circulated estimated 215 szs. cement to surface. W.O.C. 9:30 P.M., 10-18-64. After W.O.C. 18 hours, pressure tested 8-5/8" casing to 1100 psi for 30 minutes, O.K. Now drilling below 2000 feet in 7-7/8" hole.


