Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letters of March 11 and March 26, 1964, wherein you request authority to complete your State of New Mexico "AC" Well No. 9 and your State of New Mexico "AA" Well No. 3, located in Unit N of Section 2 and Unit B of Section 10, respectively, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, as single tubingless completions in the Vacuum (Abo-Reef) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the production casing string will consist of 2 7/8-inch tubing set at approximately 9,050 feet in each well with perforations from approximately 8900 feet to 9000 feet.

Inasmuch as no corrosion problem is expected and adequate measures will be taken to counteract the anticipated paraffin deposition, the Commission hereby approves the aforesaid tubingless completions, provided however, that sufficient cement shall be used on the 2 7/8-inch casing to bring the top of the cement back into the intermediate casing string.
