The Casinghead Gas Contract covering the captioned property provides for the Buyer to disburse royalties, overriding royalties, bonus payments and production payments for the account and on behalf of the Seller as the Seller shall from time to time direct.

A connection has been made to this lease, therefore, Phillips Petroleum Company, as Buyer, is obligated to make settlement for the gas as provided in the contract. Please have the oil purchaser furnish this office a statement setting out the division of ownership under which the purchaser is currently making payment for the oil. The statement should contain the following information:

1. Owners' names and addresses.
2. Amount of interest, type of interest; i.e.; working interest, royalty interest, overriding royalty interest or production payment.
3. Any interest being held in suspense or paid under bond should be so designated.
4. Interests being paid to a bank, trust, etc., should identify the party or person for whom the bank, trust, etc., is being paid.

It is essential that the oil purchaser furnish the division of ownership listing direct to us, inasmuch as the transmittal letter serves as a confirmation that the ownership is current and complete. An extra copy of this letter is enclosed in the event you desire to transmit a copy to the oil purchaser.

You should submit to us a photostatic copy of the oil and gas lease or leases and amendments thereto under which you operate the property. To enable us to prepare Direction Sheets for execution and expedite release of gas proceeds presently held in suspense, your earliest attention to the above is requested.
