Gentlemen:

Thank you for your call regarding my letter of February 6 concerning over-production on your Federal McCurdy No. 1-29 located in Unit C of Section 29, T-18-S, R-22-E. Supplement No. 289 for September authorizes a testing allowable of 1225 barrels for September and 4025 barrels for October, and your production reports indicated that you produced these volumes in September and October and that your well is in balance insofar as allowable and production is concerned.

At your earliest convenience please advise by letter as to the current status of this well. I was advised by your Mr. Snow that you were still undecided as to whether an allowable would be requested or the well plugged. However, from the production figures it would not seem logical to plug a well that made 4025 barrels during October, which is the last time you indicate the well to have been produced.

By copy of this letter I am advising McCurdy-Trammell Joint Account to make no further runs from this well until an official allowable is assigned.
