NOTES: If the permit for multiple completion will result in an unperfected well, the applicant must submit a separate application for approval of the well to be drilled and completed. If the applicant desires to drill and complete the well, then separate application for approval of the well to be drilled and completed must be submitted.

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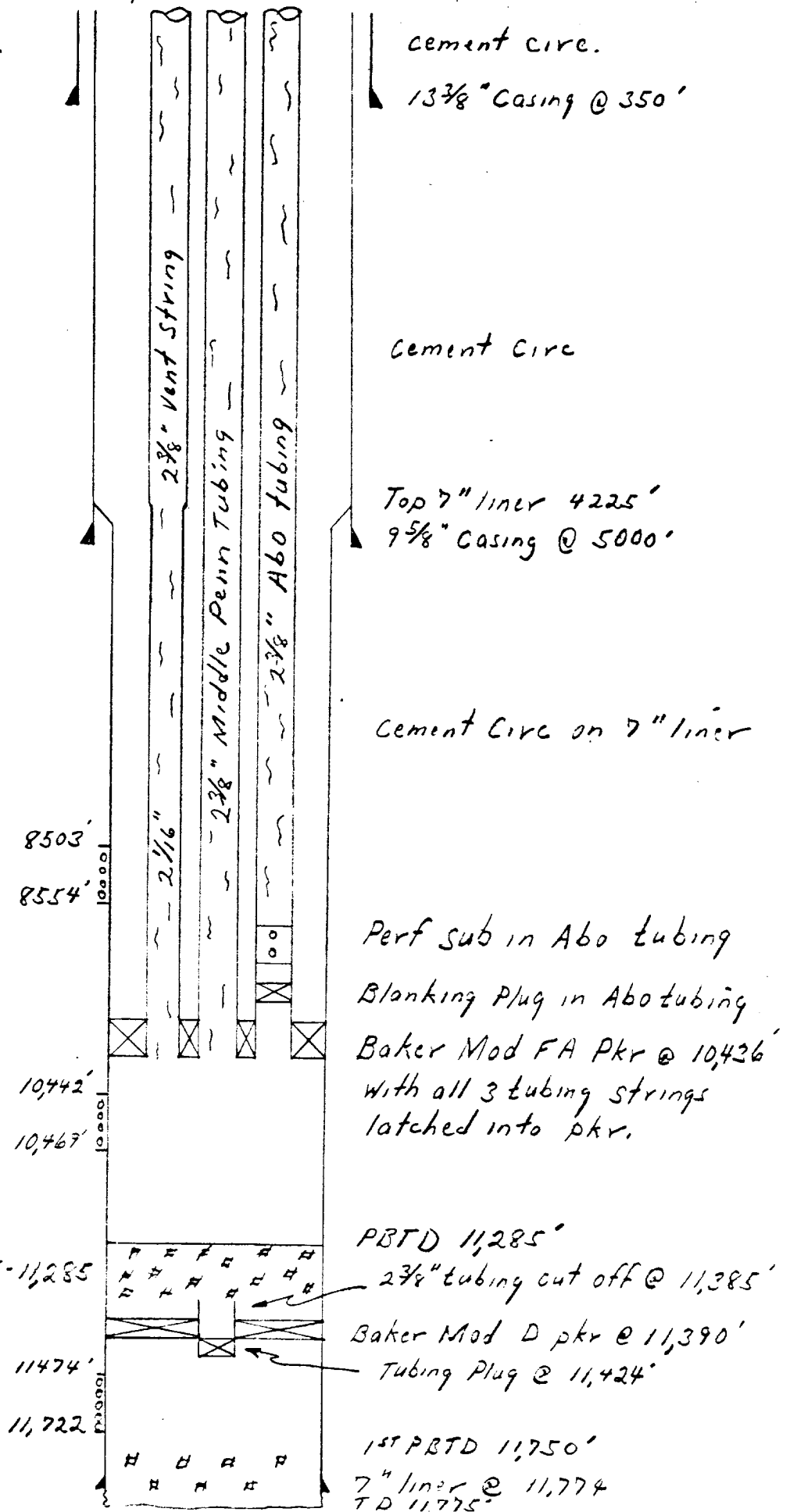
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Bridgas State #147 Proposed Completion



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
