

DEVELOPMENT PLAN
For Surface Use

P. W. Estill, Federal No. 1, 660' FSL & 660' PWL, Section 26, T18S, R33E,
Lea County, New Mexico.

1. Existing roads: See attached reproduction from USGS Laguna Catuna Quadrangle, marked Exhibit A.
2. Planned access roads: See Exhibit A. Approximately 1320 feet of road to be constructed from the Southern Union Gas Company dry hole located 1980' FSL & 710' PWL of Section 26.
3. Location of existing wells: See Exhibit B.
4. Lateral roads to well location: See Exhibit A.
5. Location of tank batteries and flow line: if well results in commercial production, tank battery to be constructed on south end of drilling pad.
6. Location and type of water supply: no water available in immediate vicinity; water for drilling to be hauled to location by tank truck.
7. Methods for handling waste disposal: All waste and debris to placed in reserve pit and covered during final clean up.
8. Location of camp: None
9. Location of airstrips: None
10. Location layout: See Exhibit C.
11. Plans for restoration of surface: All pits to be filled and levelled.
12. Other information: The terrain is sandy with minimal vegetation. No creeks, gullies or washes present to require special consideration.
