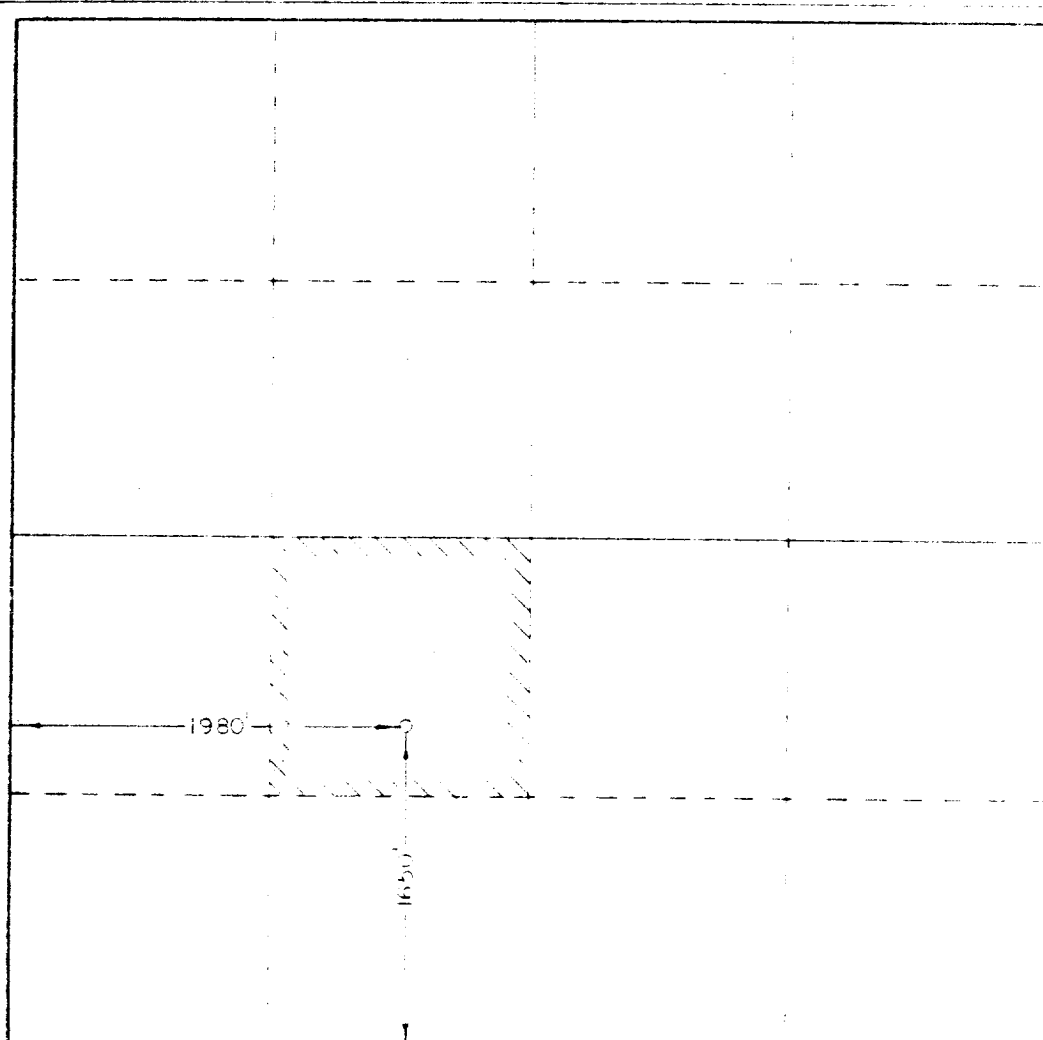

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

1. The Hobbs office (telephone (505) 393-3612) is to be notified when workover operations are to be commenced.
2. Blowout prevention equipment is required.
3. Since surface casing is not into the Rustler anhydrite formation, 4-1/2 inch casing must be cemented from the casing shoe to the surface or cemented to the surface through a stage tool set at least 50 feet below the top of the Rustler after cementing around the shoe with sufficient cement to fill to the base of the salt section.
4. Above ground permanent structures and equipment shall be painted in accordance with the attached Painting Guidelines. The paint color is to simulate Sandstone Brown, Fed. Std. 595-20318 or 30318.
