Dear Mr. Sexton:

Union Oil Company of California has recently completed Well No. 4 on its State "35" Lease to produce from the Corbin Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. We are enclosing the following reports, covering this new completion:

Form C-104 - In quintuplicate with Deviation Tests  
Form C-105 - In quintuplicate  
G-R Compensated Neutron Log - One copy

We are in the process of filing for administrative approval to commingle, above ground, the oil and gas produced from this new Queen well with oil and gas produced from the three Abo wells now on the lease. All four wells are producing at less than their individual top unit allowable. The facilities on the lease have been installed to comply with the "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities". It would be appreciated if you would give us temporary approval to commingle this production until such time as administrative approval is obtained. The Queen crude qualifies as intermediate grade crude, the same as the Abo crude now being produced on the lease. A laboratory test shows the sulphur content of the Queen crude to be 0.18%.
