

## MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

### 1. Existing Roads:

Exhibit "A" is a portion of United States Geological Survey Topographic map showing the location of the proposed well and its relationship to State Highway 529. Existing lease and area roads to be used are shown in blue with the proposed new road construction shown in red.

Exhibit "B" is a plat showing all wells, pipelines, tank batteries and existing roads within a one-mile radius of the wellsite, and the planned access road.

Existing roads from the mid-point of Section 7 to the entrance of the access road will be repaired where needed. Repairs will consist of blading and watering.

### 2. Planned Access Road:

Length and Width: New road required will be 12 feet wide and 1,700 feet long. Proposed road is shown in red on Exhibits "A" and "B". The center line of the proposed road has been staked and flagged with the stakes being visible from any one to the next.

Surfacing Material: Six inches of caliche, watered, compacted and graded.

Maximum Grade: One percent.

Turnouts: None required.

Drainage Design: None required.

Culverts: None required.

Cuts and Fills: None required.

Gates and Cattleguards: None required.

### 3. Location of Existing Wells:

Existing wells within a one-mile radius are shown on Exhibit "B".
