Due to the inability of subject well to flow, we have been unable to run the Four Point Back Pressure Test. Subject well produces excess water which causes well to die. Well died on May 1, 1979 after 5 hours flowing. Swabbed until May 7, 1979 when flow was regained. Flowed until May 20, 1979 and died again. Regained flow and well died again on May 28, 1979. Flow regained May 29, 1979. Died again on June 12, 1979. As soon as flow rate is stabilized, we will run Four Point Test and forward it to you.
