

- B. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced off until they have been backfilled.

11. TOPOGRAPHY

- A. The wellsite and access route are located on a surface gently sloping with small dunes and shallow basins.
- B. The soils are loose, non-consolidated and sandy.
- C. The vegetation cover at the wellsite area is moderately dense with shinnery, greasewood, and assorted grasses.
- D. No wildlife was observed but it is likely that rabbits, lizards, insects, and rodents traverse the area.
- E. No washes or rivers cross the area.
- F. The wellsite is location of Federal surface.
- G. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical, or cultural sites in the vicinity of the location.
