  - B. Soil: Soil is a deep fine sand and underlain by caliche.
  - C. <u>Flora and Fauna</u>: The vegetative cover is generally sparse and consists of mesquite, yucca, shinnery oak, sandsage and perennial native range grasses. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land and includes coyotes, rabbits, rodents, reptiles, dove, quail and an occasional antelope.
  - D. <u>Ponds and Streams</u>: There are no rivers, streams, lakes or ponds in the area.
  - E. <u>Residences and Other Structures</u>: No nearby residences. No structures other than tank batteries mentioned in 4a. The nearest water well is a windmill 1¼ miles northwest.
  - F. <u>Archeological, Historical and Cultural Sites</u>: None observed in the area.
  - G. Land Use: Grazing and hunting in season.
  - H. <u>Surface Ownership</u>: Wellsite and all roads are on Federal surface, with exception of roads in Section 16 which are on State land, including 660' of the planned access road.
