SUBJECT: SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELLS ON FEE SURFACE AFTER ALL FEDERAL

PRODUCING WELLS HAVE BEEN ABANDONED

I believe I wrote you a note some time ago advising that we had been informed by the BLM that according to their rules they have no jurisdiction on salt water disposal wells after the last well on the 'federal mineral lease' has been plugged if the surface is privately owned.

This week I requested from Pete Chester information concerning this BLM ruling and I am enclosing a copy of what he sent me.

It appears we have at least two disposal wells that fall into this category.

Please advise what the OCD position in regarding bonding for these wells.

The wells I am concerned about are: Okie Crude Co. N.M. D Fed #1 SWD Unit A, Sec. 29-T8S-R36E Floyd Oper.Co. Jennings B Fed #2-N 15-19-32
