

SURFACE USE AND OPERATING PLAN

1. **Existing Roads:**

- A. The well site and elevation plat for the proposed Scott "E" Federal #1 are attached.
- B. Directions to location: Travel from Carlsbad, New Mexico east on highway 62/180, exit @ Hwy 243; travel north to the Zia Plant blacktop; from that intersection travel 7.9 miles on CR 126 to caliche road and the cattle guard on the east side of the road. Proceed 2.2 miles east; turn northeast, northwest, then north for a total of 1 mile; turn west for 3/4 mile; at Keel "A" Federal #1, turn north and travel 1.0 mile.

2. **Existing access Road:**

- A. The maximum width of the road is fifteen (15) feet.
- B. It is crowned and made of 6 inches of rolled and compacted caliche. Water will be deflected, as necessary, to avoid accumulation and prevent surface erosion.
- C. If any surface material is required, it will be native caliche. The material will be obtained from a BLM approved pit nearest in proximity to the location or from existing caliche under the location.
- D. No cattle guards, grates or fence cuts will be necessary.
- E. No turnouts are planned.
