No stimulation program is expected at this time, but should it be deemed necessary to acidize the present perforations or proposed perforations an acidizing program will be presented to the OCD at a later date.

Part X

All logs and test data have been submitted to the OCD.

Part XI

There are two fresh water wells within a mile of the proposed. The nearest well is located approximately 1/2 mile from the proposed well in the lower portion of the SE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 35, Township 18 South, Range 34 East. Reports from the State Engineers Office in Roswell show the latest test of this well in December 1984 to have approximately 750 ppm chlorides.

The second well is located in the NE/4 of the NW/4 of the same section. This is about three quarters of a mile away from the proposed well. No data is yet available on this well.
