An inspection of your <u>Amoco State Well #1-M in Sec 8, T18S, R34E</u>, was made by an OCD Inspector on September 8, 1983, and he reports that produced water was being put in an unlined pit at time of inspection.

As you know, this is a violation of Division Rules and Regulations and is considered a hazard to our underground fresh water supply. You are requested to set a tank for collection of produced water, or shut the well in.

We will recheck the area within a few days.
