### Gentlemen:

Phillips 66 Natural Gas Company's records indicate the Anadarko Petroleum Corporation operated Harvard Well No. 1 in the Foster San Andres Pool is overproducing the Commission assigned daily gas limit. Our purchase records show the Well No. 1 to have produced at a daily average of 840 MCF per day in June, 892 MCF per day in August, and 921 MCF per day in September, 1987. The top casinghead gas limit for the Foster San Andres Pool is 800 MCF per day.

Phillips respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Division contact Anadarko Petroleum Corporation to have their overproduction made up and to maintain their daily production rate at the allowed 800 MCF per day rate.
