Central Corbin Queen Unit Well No. 203  
Lea County, New Mexico**

Dear Ms. Husband:

Reference is made to your request to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Division) received December 5, 2002, to increase the surface injection pressure on the subject well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted November 26, 2002. Results of the test have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are hereby authorized to inject water at pressures up to the following maximum surface tubing pressure.

Well and Location	Maximum Surface Tubing Pressure
Central Corbin Queen Unit No. 203 API:30-025-29364	2400 PSIG
This well is located in Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
