Dear Ms. Husband:

Reference is made to your request to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Division) received December 12, 2002, to increase the surface injection pressure on the subject well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted December 5, 2002. Results of the test have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are hereby authorized to inject water at pressures up to the following maximum surface tubing pressure.
