Acidized thru Queen Perfs @ 4270 - 4279' w/1900 gals 7-1/2% NeFe HCl acid. Max press 2300#, min press 1800#, ATP 2000#, AIR 5.0 BPM, ISIP 1780#, 5 min SIP 1380#, 10 min SIP 990#, 15 min SIP 600#. Fraced thru Queen Perfs @ 4270 - 4279' w/22,000 gals cross-linked gelled 2% KCL (40# system) water w/5% diesel + 6000# 20/40 sand + 58,000# 12/20 sand. Max press 4800#, min press 4300#, ATP 4500#, AIR 20.0 BPM, ISIP 2620#, 5 min SIP 2620#, 10 min SIP 2600#, 15 min SIP 2590#. 14 hr. SITP 35#. Flowed 4 BO + 133 BW/10 hrs. thur 1" choke, FTP 100 - 20#. Swabbed 2 BO + 155 BW/3 hrs. and then swabbed Tr. Oil + 102 BW/10 hrs. POOH w/tubing and packer. RIH w/2-3/8" tubing and test packer and set the packer @ 4205'. ND BOP's, NU WH and shut well in for pressure build up.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
