Gentlemen:

The above-referenced well was sold by Primary Fuels Inc. to Tempo Energy Inc. Primary Fuels as operator at the time the well was drilled should have filed Form C-105, deviation surveys, and one set of logs with the Oil Conservation Division.

Tempo Energy's recompletion attempt was unsuccessful and the well was ultimately plugged. In order to complete the necessary records required on all wells drilled in New Mexico, we requested Tempo to file Form C-105, deviation surveys, and one set of logs. Mr. Garber with Tempo advises they do not have information necessary to comply with our request. Since Geodyne took over Primary Fuels we are writing to you in hopes that you will be able to supply this information to us or furnish it to Tempo so they will be able to comply with this requirement.
