The above-referenced well was sold by Primary Fuels Inc. to Tempo Energy Inc. Primary Fuels as operator at the time the well was drilled should have filed Form C-105, deviation surveys, and one set of logs with the Oil Conservation Division.

Tempo Energy's recompletion attempt was unsuccessful and the well was ultimately plugged.
