2. Set bridge plug to temporarily SI perfs 9,491-9,523'. Current prod is 3 BOPD, 8 BWPD and 19 MCFPD.
3. Perforate, acidize and test Bone Spring Carbonate interval 7,452-7,460'.
4. Remove bridge plug and produce all Bone Spring intervals together.

Estimated start date is sometime in Dec. '00, depending on rig availability and project scheduling.  
Approximate duration is 20 days, depending on results and testing required for each zone.
