

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. If the proposal is to deepen directionally or recompleate horizontally, give subsurface locations and measured and true vertical depths of all pertinent markers and zone. 1. Set CIBP @ 10,900' to temporarily abandon Wolfcamp perms. Current Wolfcamp test is 16 BOPD, 9 BWPD, 44 MCFPD.
2. Perforate squeeze holes @ 8430' & 8120' and circ cmt in 5-1/2" csg annulus. Drill out and pressure test.
3. Perforate 2nd Bone Spring Carbonate 8775-8780'.
4. Acidize perms 8775-8780' w/1500 gals 15% NEFE HCL.
5. Perforate 1st Bone Spring Sand 8683-8708'.
6. Fracture stimulate perms 8683-8780'.
7. Set CIBP @ 8670'. Perforate 1st Bone Spring Sand 8374-8392', 8454', 8456', 8458', 8460', 8496', 8498', 8500', 8502'.
8. Fracture stimulate perms 8374-8502'.
9. Drill out CIBP @ 8670' and put on pump from Bone Spring perms 8374-8780'

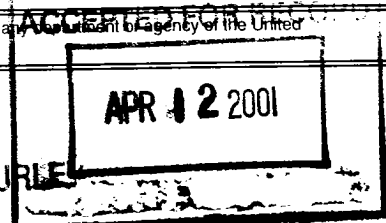
Estimated start date is February 1, 2001, depending on rig availability and project scheduling.
