Recomplete and test Bone Spring

1. Set CIBP @ +/- 11090' w/ 10' cement cap to temporarily abandon Wolfcamp perms 11123' - 11264'.
2. Perf squeeze holes @ +/- 10400' & circulate cement above zones of interest.
3. Perforate and fracture stimulate 2nd Bone Spring Sand 9626' - 9670'. Set CBP @ 9575'
4. Perforate and fracture stimulate 1st Bone Spring Sand 8714' - 8838'.
5. Drill out CBP @ 9575' and clean out to 11070'.
6. Put on pump and test Bone Spring perms 8714' - 9670'.

Estimated start date is 3/10/2003 depending on rig availability.
