13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. 1. Temporarily abandon Wolfcamp pay (11,139-11,247' OA) by setting bridge plug @ 9,700'.
2. Perforate, stimulate and test five separate Bone Spring intervals, progressing from the deepest (9,582') to the shallowest (7,430').
3. Commingle and produce all Bone Spring intervals until production rate stabilizes after initial decline (est. 1-6 months).
4. Obtain approval to downhole commingle all Bone Spring and Wolfcamp intervals.
