Phillips Petroleum Company previously requested administrative approval of an unorthodox location for the Vacuum Abo Unit, Tract 14, Well No. 05, in the Vacuum Abo Reef Pool. This well was to be located 1375' FSL and 330' FWL of Section 5, T-18-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

It has been established to move the location of the well due to electrical lines. The new location is 1475' FSL and 430' FWL of Section 5, T-18-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The well is too close to the quarter-quarter section. This well is a replacement well for the Well 14-04 in the Vacuum Abo Unit. It is located to take advantage of structure and net pay within the 40-acre tract.


