Mr. Lemay:

Marathon Oil Company has recently completed a new drill well. This letter is being submitted to the State of New Mexico Oil Conservation Division with a C-104 requesting a test allowable.

Marathon Oil Company is in the process of installing a production flowline from the wellhead to the existing Warn St. A/C 2 battery. However, during the installation process, Marathon is testing the oil into temporary tanks located on the Warn St. A/C 2 No. 26 location.

Marathon Oil Company is proposing to utilize Kelly Maclaskey Oilfield Services (OGRID 012426) to transport the oil from the Warn St. A/C 2 No. 26 location to the existing Warn St. A/C 2 battery. At the Warn St. A/C 2 battery, Marathon will utilize the existing lact meter equipment to sale oil to TX-NM Pipeline Company (OGRID 22628).
