

Training Program

A. Training Requirements

When working in an area where hydrogen sulfide gas (H₂S) might be encountered, definite training requirements must be carried out. The Cross Timbers approved supervisor will ensure that all personnel at the well site has had adequate training in the following:

1. Hazards and characteristics of hydrogen sulfide gas.
2. Physical effects of hydrogen sulfide on the human body.
3. Toxicity of hydrogen sulfide and sulfur dioxide.
4. Hydrogen sulfide detection.
5. Emergency rescue.
6. Resuscitators.
7. First aid and artificial resuscitation.
8. The effects of hydrogen sulfide on metals.
9. Location safety.

Service company personnel and visiting personnel must be notified if the zone contains hydrogen sulfide, and each service company must provide adequate training and equipment for their employees before they arrive at the well site.
