As a follow-up to our telephone conversation of several weeks ago, please be advised that Leede Operating Company, L.L.C. and its co-venturer, Sahara Operating Company, plan to begin filing for regulatory approval to drill and complete the captioned well in search of oil and/or gas by the end of October 1998.

Enclosed is another copy of a topographical map indicating our preferred location of the well which will be 400 feet from the south line and 400 feet from the west line of Section 7, T18S R38E. We hope to survey and stake the location in the next couple of weeks and also begin discussing the settlement of surface damages with the City of Hobbs. According to our review of the Lea County, New Mexico records, the City of Hobbs owns the surface at our proposed location.
