Seely Oil Company's McElvain "A" Federal Well No. 1 was completed from perforations in the Delaware from 5780' to 5857' overall during July, 2000.

During August, 2000, additional interval in the Delaware was perforated from 5508' to 5513', acidized, fracture treated and commingled with production from the 5780' to 5857' perforations.

On September 5, 2000, this well produced 100 barrels of oil, 1 barrel of water, and 49 MCF gas from all Delaware perforations.
