

## EMERGENCY CONDITIONS

### Operating Conditions

#### 1. Emergency Procedures and Definitions of Warning Flags:

##### A. Condition:

Green.....Normal Operations

##### B. Condition:

Yellow.....Potential Danger, Condition

##### Causes for condition:

- a. Circulating up drilling breaks
- b. Trip gas after trip
- c. Circulating out gas on choke
- d. Poisonous gas present, but below threshold concentration

##### Safety Action:

- a. Check safety equipment and keep it with you
- b. Be alert for a change in condition
- c. Follow instructions.

##### C. Condition:

Red.....Extreme Danger

##### Cause for Condition:

- a. Uncontrolled flow from well with lethal concentrations of H<sub>2</sub>S.

##### Safety Action:

- a. "Masks up" all personnel will have protective breathing equipment with them.  
All personnel will stay in "Safe Briefing Area" unless instructed to do otherwise.
- b. Order evacuation of local people within the danger zone.
