## DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

This well was drilled to total depth of 4295' without encountering oil or gas production, and has been abandoned, plugging as follows. The hole was filled with heavy mud and a cement plug of 40 sacks was spotted 4295' to 4080'. Pulled all 7" casing and spotted the following cement plugs: 30 sacks, 3645'-3545'; 20 sacks, 2987'-2920' (at base of salt); and 20 sacks, 1449'-1382' (in bottom of 8-5/8" casing). Parted and pulled 8-5/8" casing at 823' and spotted a cement plug of 20 sacks, 838'-810' and 20 sacks, 685'-657'. The customary 4" pipe marker was cemented in the top of the hole with 20 sacks of cement. Above work completed 12-4-44. Since that date, location has been cleaned up and is now ready for inspection

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
