Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your Notice of Intention to Drill well Federal 18 No. 2 (copy attached), SE $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 18, T. 19 S., R. 33 E., N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, on lease Las Cruces 064790. Inasmuch as a portion of the lease lies within the potash area designated by the order of the Secretary of the Interior dated October 16, 1951, the Director, U. S. Geological Survey must approve the drilling of all shallow wells on the lease.

Pursuant to the authority delegated by the Director, U. S. Geological Survey, on March 30, 1960, I hereby approve the Notice of Intention to Drill the above described well to a depth of approximately 3,300 feet to test the Yates and Seven Rivers formations.
