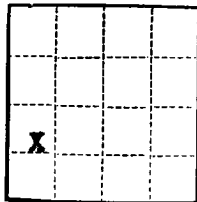

DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to drill this well with rotary tools to an approximate depth of 3300 feet. Approximately 250 feet of 8-5/8" casing will be cemented back to the surface. Production string will be 5-1/2" casing set near bottom and cemented back to the anhydrite above the salt section. Well will be completed by perforating 5-1/2" casing.
