our original plans were then to perforate the 8-5/8" casing and complete as a water sell; however, intention to change plans and abundon this well was approved 11-22-44, and balance of hole was plugged as follows. The c-5/8" casing was parted and called at approximately 780°, and cement plans spotted as follows to protect water sand from 690° to 760°: 20 sacks, 788-760°, and 20 sacks, 690-662°. We were able to recover only 3.0° of 10-3/4" casing, which had been madded at 675°, and the 13-3/8" casing was left cemented in the hole. The required 4" pipe marker was comented in the top of the hole with 20 sacks of cement.

All above work was completed on 12-16-44, and the location is now cleaned up and ready for inspection.
