This letter will serve to notify you of International's acceptance of the proposed plugging schedule for the Magnolia State oil test located 660 FNL, 1980 FEL, Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Under the plugging schedule we have accepted, you will place a 15 sack cement plug at a depth of 3251', fill the 5½" casing to 980' with drilling mud, cut and recover the top 800' of casing, place a 10-15 sack cement plug over the stub, and finally place a 15 sack surface plug.
