You are hereby notified that it is our intention to shoot Western-Texas Well
No. 1 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 17 T. 17S, R. 34E, N. M. P. M.,
Oil Field Lea County

Unless already filed a copy of the well log accompanies this notice. Present production is
60 barrels per day of oil and 2 barrels per day of water. Water comes in at 4445

Formation to be shot: Top is at 4465 feet, bottom at 4750 feet.

Inner string of casing set at 4400 feet.

Well is to be shot with 200 quarts.

Purpose of shot is Increase production

Name of torpedo company or shooter is Liberty Torpedo Co., Big Springs, Tex.

Additional information: Plugged back to 1004 feet with gravel and set
male and female wooden plug. Set fifteen feet gravel on top of
wooden plug and then set 6 lead mol plugs (575 pounds) and
shut sulphur water off. Plugged back with gravel to 4763 feet
and set 2 sacks cement and filled hole with gravel to 4750 feet,
steel line measurement.
