NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon State Well
No. 1 in 17 of Sec. 17 of Sec. 17, T. 17, R. 17
N. M. P. M., 17 Oil Field, 17 County.
We plan to commence work on April 23rd, 1931.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Not a good well

The present condition of the well is as follows:

Plugged to 1200 feet. - tubing cut & successfully shut off.

ILLEGIBLE

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Plug back to bottom of 15" pipe (4400') with heavy mud, set
5 sacks of cement. After pulling pipe, plug back with heavy mud,
setting 5 sacks cement at bottom of well and 5 sacks cement on
top of salt. Set 5 sacks cement bottom of 15" pipe and 5 sacks
cement on top of surface water sand. Cement surface of hole and
leave regulation marker.
