Well No. 1 in SE NW of Sec. 17 T. 17 S R. 34 E,
 N.M.P.M., Oil Field Lea County.

DETAILS

State names of and expected depths to objective sands or producing horizon; show sizes, weights, and lengths of casing run or proposed; indicating mudding jobs, cementing points, water horizon, number of days operated, and total depth at end of month, and other important information.

Plugged back to bottom of 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pipe with heavy mud and set five sacks of cement, pulled 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pipe and left approximately 200 feet of pipe in hole. Plugged back with heavy mud, set in five sacks of cement at bottom of salt and five sacks of cement at the top of salt. Left approximately 1050 feet of 10" pipe in hole. Set five sacks of cement at bottom of 15" pipe, filled with heavy mud and set five sacks cement on top of surface water sand. Filled balance of hole with heavy mud and set regulation marker consisting of 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pipe.
