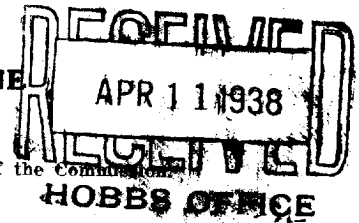

Additional information:

This well was drilled to a TD of 4740'. 2" EUE seamless tubing was run to 4726'. Pulled swab on well 6 times on April 6, 1938, well started flowing. Flowed into pits for 3 1/2 hours, and then turned into tanks at 11:50 a.m. In 19 hours and 10 minutes, well made a total of 397 barrels of pipe line oil. Casing pressure 160#; tubing pressure 75#. This test was thru 3/4" choke. Gas volume 323,000 cubic feet daily. Gas oil ratio 709. No acid treatment made.
